



Oil Paintings by Mark Cook

“The United Club at Lunch”



Mark Cook is an accomplished artist who has been resident in Guernsey since 2001. He has agreed to produce two oil paintings of Club members at lunch in an informal and spontaneous style rather than posed. It is proposed that the paintings, once completed, will be hung in a prominent position in the club.

Each painting will show twelve members down the length of the dining room, rather like the last supper and half seated on one side of the table and half on the other side. Mark is very enthusiastic about this project, which will be in the style of 18th and 19th society portraits and he will work from photographs taken in the Club as members lunch.

The cost will be borne by those included in the pictures and the indicative cost is £425 per member. If the number of willing sitters exceeds 24, priority will be given to regular lunchers and to members who have contributed greatly to the Club in other ways. It may also be possible to cater for a more than 24 should the demand be strong.
